How will both you and I know how my child is doing and how will you help me to support their learning?

The school regularly monitors and reviews provision for pupils. This information is shared informally and through more formal occasions such as parents evening to discuss targets, provision and wellbeing. Further to this, interim and annual reports are given, but parents are actively encouraged to first and foremost discuss concerns with their class teacher when they arise. Support can then be put in place and strategies and support given.

In addition, if a child has an EHCP or SEND Support Plan, parents will be invited in for regular reviews to ensure targets are up to date. During these, it may be appropriate to consult outside agencies to ensure the best support for parents and children are being provided. The class teacher will also provide suggested strategies and resources to assist in your child's learning. Parents will also be actively encouraged to sign up to the FIND newsletter, so that they can access and see programmes offered within the county.

Learn this term meetings will also be held to ensure parents are kept up to date with current classroom practice.
